We agreed any fundraising efforts would go towards this request. Our fundraising efforts included: Grysiuk's Honey, Valentine's Sock Hop and Cookie Dough. We raised \$2,600, as we had \$300 leftover from last year's efforts. We committed \$2,500 towards new playground equipment.

We held 8 meetings throughout the year. All meetings offered free lunch and babysitting. This year we had 2 student representatives who would come and share each classroom's highlights of what they are doing and working on. It was very good to have them there, especially when we discuss ideas for what is needed at the school and to have a student perspective on issues.

We did not have a PRO grant for this year, however we are applying for one next year.

In general news our French Immersion and Hockey Academy programs went over really well and are excited for the future of these programs in our school and how that attracts other families to join our school.
